Reading


- They will focusing on Non-Fiction texts, practicing the skill of retrieving information form the text and justifying their responses.
- To support your child at home please read with them for at least 15mins daily, asking them questions about the text they have read and encouraging them to make prediction about the text.
- In Accelerated reader we are aiming that children read a book every week.
- As a reminder our class reader is Michael Morpurgo.

Writing

Our writing units this half term are based around the story 'The Egyptian Cinderella' and 'There's a Pharaoh in my Bath.'. The children will be writing a character description, narrative and a debate on who should keep artefacts linking it to their topic.

The SPAG objectives we will be focusing on in our writing this half term are:

- Using figurative language to describe.
- Using a range of cohesive conjunctions to join sentences.
- Using a relative clauses beginning with 5Ws



Punctuality

It is really important to get to school on time at **8:45am.** In soft start we learn spellings and if pupils arrive after 9am then they will not be able to do the spelling test each week as well as other children.
