Role Play





Phonics

This term we will begin learning our letters and sounds. For the next 5 weeks we will focus on:

m, a, s, d, t

Spanish, Art, Music & PE

Spanish with Ms Fossy will be held on Monday. Children will be learning numbers and colours and some basic phrases. Muy bien!

Art with Ms Castellvi will be held on Tuesday. Sessions will incorporate this terms topic and activities will range from using fruit to print, exploring textures and colours through art.

Music with Mr Holley will be held on Thursday.

Sessions will include learning songs from around the world and those that represent the children's backgrounds.

PE with the BADU coaches will take place on Thursday.

The children will be learning to use their bodies in a variety of ways, all promoting the development of health & well being. Please bring children in suitable clothing on the day.

Maths

This half term our objectives are

- learning to recite and count in cardinal order from 1-10
- Use number names and language
- Explore quantities- comparing groups, same, more, less
- Select amounts of objects from a group

Please practise this at home with your child or out and about in the park!

Encourage reading numbers on buses, cars,



door numbers etc Ask your child to give you an amount when out shopping. "can you give 4 apples?"

Mark Making

This half term our mark making objectives are:

- Learning to independently make controlled marks
- Use a three fingered 'tripod grasp'
- Use a variety of writing tools
- Use a variety of materials- paper, white boards, chalk boards

Support at home by building hand strength!



Playdough and squeezy toys help develop children's muscles. Drawing patterns helps control. Try doing zebra stripes and scaly fish!
