During our topic we will try and visit the local area and a bus ride around London City








Maths

- To recognise the number of objects in a small group without counting.


Homework will give parents the opportunity to support key concepts at home.

In reading, we will begin to demonstrate our understanding of what we have read. To help with this, you could ask your child questions about the stories read at bedtime.


