



#### Maths

This half term our objectives are

- To know that numbers identify how many objects are in a set
- Use number names and language
- Explore quantities- comparing groups, same, more, less
- To know that a group of things changes in quantity when something is added or taken away

Please practise the above at home with your child or when out and about in the park!



Encourage reading numbers on buses, cars, door numbers

Ask your child to give you an amount when out shopping. "can you give 4 apples?"

# Mark Making

This half term our mark making objectives are:

- Representing or writing our names
- Use of a three fingered 'tripod grasp'
- Use anti-clockwise movements and retrace vertical lines
- Ascribing a meaning to marks that are seen in different places

Support at home by building hand strength!
