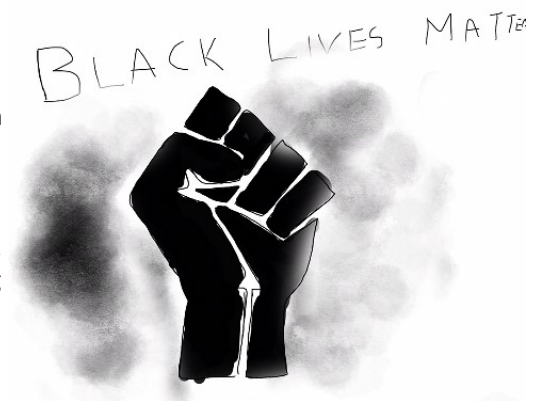
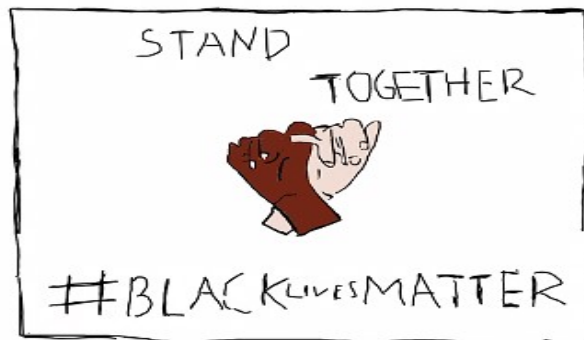
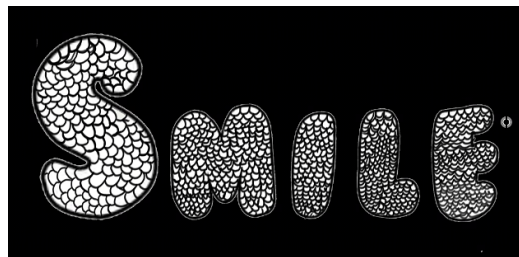
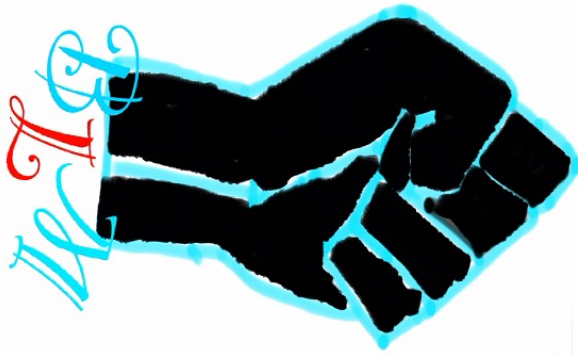


Summer 2 Week 5
