We will be using the Rose White maths planning which is amazing! We will learn...


- To find/ say the number which is one more or one less than a given number.

This half term we will be learning about Journeys, Materials, Diwali and Christmas. and Diwali. Our Topic books focus texts for this half term are:










Writing
