- 2 tablespoons of cream of tartar
- 2 tablespoons of oil or baby lotion
 I cup of hot water
- Combine the dry ingredients in a bowl, add the oil or baby lotion and then the water.

You could also add some food colouring here if you would like a colourful

dongh.

Stir everything together and then knead the dough until you are happy with the consistency.
