












Home Learning Zooms

Wow- you have done well this week. We have seen a huge increase in feedback of home learning on our school Instagram, a great uptake in Reading Plus in years 4, 5, 6 and we have had some lovely feedback about our teachers zoom lessons.

We have listened to parent, pupil and staff feedback on our learning packages. As a result we will extend our zoom sessions for years 1-6. Children in years 1 and 2 will have a zoom from 10am- 12.30pm, this will consist of phonics 10-10.15am, writing 10.15-11am, 30 min break and time to check in with teachers, then maths 11.30-12.30pm. Years 3, 4, 5, 6 will have writing 10-11am, a thirty min break or catch up with the teacher, then maths 11.30-12.30pm. We have created one zoom link so children and parents can access one session and stay online. These links are in your packs and on the website under parents/ home learning. We hope this supports maths home learning better.

Teachers are always grateful for the positive feedback we receive. We have had so many wonderful comments this week about the input, home learning and children's achievements and we are fiercely proud of our new army of home learning teachers- you are doing a great job!
