Punctuality

It is really important to get to school on time. We open our doors at 8.45 for soft start. In soft start we have different activities to support children's development. We close the doors at 9am. Anyone arriving after 9am will need to go to the main office.

The EYFS Curriculum

There are 7 areas of the EYFS curriculum Our focus in Reception is on:

We will also provide opportunities in the environment for children to investigate and explore the Specific Areas

- Literacy (writing/reading)
- Maths
- Understanding the World
- Expressive Arts and Design

Our indoor and outdoor continuous provision covers all of the 7 areas so that children can develop skills in each area.

Reading

There will be lots of reading opportunities in the Reception class. Children will read 1:1 as well as in groups.

We will begin continue to teach the children to read using Read Write Inc phonics programme. The children now know a number of different sounds and are learning how to blend the sounds to read words.

Maths

This half term, children will be developing their understanding of number through concrete and pictorial representations (objects and drawings to support counting). Children will be introduced to abstract methods (written numbers) when they are confident to build on their understanding of number. We will be focusing on:

- Counting numbers to 10
- Representing numbers
- Composition of numbers
- Geometry (circles and triangles)
- Positional language

Supporting children at home will help their understanding. For example, counting toys, putting cups out, counting steps on the way home, showing a number of fingers 'all at once' without counting etc.
