### Reading

- In Year One, we use the RWI programme to support reading.

### RE and Values

In Values the children will be thinking about how we can give to others. We will be talking about generosity and learning how the Jewish and Christian faiths celebrate.

### Maths

In maths this half term we are covering

- **Place Value**—recognising numbers within 10 and 20. Writing our numbers in words.
- **Addition and subtraction**—adding and taking away using various strategies and knowledge of number bonds.
- **Geometry/ Shapes**—Recognise and name common 2D and 3D shapes and the different features.


Please practice counting 2's, 5's and 10's at home with your child. The weekly maths homework covers everything that we have learnt in maths that week.



### Writing

In writing this term we will be focusing on a range of writing styles:

- We will be using *Dogger* by Shirley Hughes to inspire our story writing.
- Narrative— Retelling the story of *Dogger* using our own experience of our favourite toys.
- Instructions—we will be writing instructions on how to make a jam sandwich!



### Art

Our topic this term is all about toys! We will be looking at similarities and differences between toys from the past and now. Children will also be looking at how games have changed over time. They will also have a chance to play with toys from the past and make their own toys.



### ICT

- We will be using various ICT programmes to assist in our learning.
- We will code and create our own games using Espresso Coding.
- We will also start to use google classroom.
