## **Gainsborough Keeps Campaign**

Our class campaign this term links to keeping safe. Throughout the term the children will learn how to keep safe around water. They will enjoy a visit from the canal river trust. During the visit the children will learn how to stay safe when around water.

#### Writing

Our writing units this half term are based around our topic Explorers and Adventurer's. Our focus book will be 'Sophie Scott Goes South' by Alison Lester. During our writing lessons this term we will focus on our Recount writing by completing diary entries from the perspective of Sophie Scott. The children will use their imagination to write captivating narratives and setting descriptions when they show off their knowledge about the Antarctic!

### Reading

This half-term we will be starting with a non-fiction text, 'I wonder why penguins can't fly'. We will then be reading 'Race to the frozen North' by Catherine Johnson. Children will discuss authors choice of language, develop retrieval skills and make relevant predictions. Make sure to spend at least 30 minutes on reading plus per week and bring your reading log every day!

#### **Maths**

The children will start this term learning about money. We will be recognising and comparing value and then learning how to convert from pounds to pence/pence-pounds.

We will then focus on manipulating the additive relationship and securing mental calculation, using our knowledge of partitioning, multiples of 10 and 100 and efficiency.

Each week your child should be logging on to TT Rockstars and Mathletics for at least 30 minutes! Can you get your Bronze certificate?





### **ICT**

This term the children in Year 3 will focus on internet safety. They will learn how to keep safe online when using the internet.

## **History & Geography**

During History and Geography this term our focus in Year 3 will be Adventurers and Exploders. The children will learn about significant figures of the past such as Ernest Shackleton and his voyage to the Antarctic. They will continue to develop their geographical understanding by identifying countries and continents in the Northern and Southern hemisphere as well as understanding the link between climate and the earths equator. The children will think practically about what supplies could be needed when going on an adventure and the problems that different terrains and climates could bring. We hope that their topic this term will spark their awe and wonder of the world as we evaluate different archaeological finds that have helped humans to understand their past.

#### Science

This term in Year 3 the children will be learning about light. They will understand how light travels and how it affects how we see. They will use words to describe light and shadows such as 'opaque', 'transparent' and 'translucent'.
