As a school we will be focusing on Keep Green:





Our learning will be centred around The Victorians this term.

Reading for Pleasure!

We have been looking at how we can enjoy reading, why we should read outside of lessons and what books we would like more of in our classes. Did you complete the reading challenge with your child? What books have they read? What did you learn about their reading and their interests? These are the books we have read this year so far, can you talk to your child about these books?







Reading

This half term we will be reading Frankenstein as our class reader. We will practise our summarising skills by identifying the main events from what we have read and completing summaries in our reading logs. It is a book full of different scenery and the children will enjoy learning new vocabulary!

Our reading lessons will focus on a range of reading skills including:

- Finding information in the text
- Understanding new vocabulary in context and considering why an author uses these words
- Using clues from the text to work out the feelings of characters
- Making predictions about what will happen next

Writing

Our writing units this half term will be based around our topic of The Victorians and the novel Oliver Twist by Charles Dickens. . Using this text, the children will write a suspenseful narrative about Oliver Twist asking for more food at the orphanage The children will then write a diary entry about life as a Victorian child. During this unit, the pupils will focus on direct speech, similes, creating suspense by using short sentences and ambitious vocabulary.

Campaign

Our class campaign this term is linked to Keep Green. We will consider how to reduce our carbon footprint and track this using an online tool.

Science

Our Science topic this half term will be around Living things and their habitats. We will explore different habitats around the world. We will also be learning about food chains and what things are living, dead or never alive.

We will develop our scientific skills by recording our results and observations, drawing conclusions and evaluating the accuracy of our investigation and results.

ICT

Our topic this half term is 'Creating media- desktop publishing. We will develop our understanding of using media to edit photos.

PSHE
