






Reading











This half term we will be reading 'Viking Invasion' by June Crebbin as our class reader. We will practise our summarising skills by identifying the main ideas from what we have read and completing summaries in our reading logs. It is a book full of information about the Viking invasion of Britain, providing lots of information about how the Vikings went into battle!

Our reading lessons will focus on a range of reading skills including:

- Retrieving information in the text
- Understanding new vocabulary in context and considering why an author uses these words
- Using clues from the text to work out the feelings of characters
- Making comparisons within and across different texts
- Recommending books to others

To support your child at home, please read with them every day. In year 5 we are also really focusing on our use of Reading Plus. ### Writing

Our writing units this half term will be based around our topic of 'The Vikings' and the text 'Viking Invasion.' Using this text, the children will write a diary entry from the perspective of a Viking about to invade Britain. In addition, we will use this learning and our learning in history to write a poem and

a non-chronological report about the Vikings and their settlements, invasions, customs and legacy.

During these units, the pupils will focus on using fronted adverbials and passive verbs.



- Adding ir- to words beginning with r e.g. regular and **ir**regular
- Adding the suffix -ion e.g. confess and confession

#### Maths

In Maths this half term, we will be covering:

**Geometry-** the different types of angle, how to measure angles, parallel and perpendicular lines and different types of polygons (shapes).

**Position and direction-** plotting coordinates on a grid, reflecting shapes and translating (moving) shapes. <u>Year 5 Lines and angles - Year 5 Maths - BBC Bitesize</u>

## History and Geography

In History, we will be learning about The Vikings and will explore Vikings invasions and settlements. The children will investigate Viking lifestyles and beliefs and will consider what made the Vikings so successful.

Our class campaign this term is linked to 'Keep Safe.' We will be learning about road safety and will select Junior Road Safety Officers from our class to represent Gainsborough. We will present our ideas about road safety to the school.

### Science

Our Science topic this half term will be around Life Cycles and Reproduction. We will explore the life cycles of different animal groups We will also be learning about pollination and the reproductive parts of plants.

We will develop our scientific skills by researching, recording our results and observations, drawing conclusions and evaluating the accuracy of our investigation and results.

#### **ICT**

Our topic this half term is 'Creating Media- Vector Drawing.' We will develop our understanding of how to use different drawing tools and how to use these to create images.

#### **PSHE**

This half term our PSHE unit is 'Relationships.' During this topic, the children will consider the positive personal qualities that they have. We will explore the positives and negatives associated with belonging to an online community and think about how to lower our screen time and stay safe online.

#### RE

Our focus religion this half term is Christianity. Our key question is 'How significant is it for Christians to believe that God intended Jesus to die?' We will learn about Christian religious practices and beliefs.

#### PF.

PE lessons this half term will focus on Fitness and Athletics.

### Music

The children will be exploring pop ballads, in particular the song 'Make you feel my love.' The children will be developing their ability to create and write music. In addition, we will begin rehearsing for the Hackney Music Festival.

In Spanish, our focus for this half term is 'Transport.' The children will learn how to use language linked to transport, journeys and space.

#### Art

This half term in art, the children will be creating Viking shields linked to their history topic.

# Cooking

This half term we will be making pastries in our cooking lessons. Year 5 will make tarts.
