We hope you have had a wonderful half term and are ready for an action packed Summer 2!


As a school we will be focusing on Keep Healthy:




Our learning will be centred around Royalty this term.

Reading for Pleasure!

We have been looking at how we can enjoy reading, why we should read outside of lessons and what books we would like more of in our classes. Did you complete the reading challenge with your child? What books have they read? What did you learn about their reading and their interests? These are the books we have read this year so far, can you talk to your child about these books?





Reading

This half term we will be reading Journey to the Centre of the Earth as our class reader. We will practise our summarising skills by identifying the main events from what we have read and completing summaries in our reading logs. It is a book full of different scenery and the children will enjoy learning new vocabulary!

Our reading lessons will focus on a range of reading skills including:

- Finding information in the text
- Understanding new vocabulary in context and considering why an author uses these words
- Using clues from the text to work out the feelings of characters
- Making predictions about what will happen next

Writing

Our writing units this half term will be based around our topic of Natural Disasters and we will be reading When the Giant Stirred. Using this text, the children will write a story about the main events of When the Giant Stirred. The focus will be the use of fronted adverbials. Finally, children will write introductory letters to their new teachers in preparation for the next academic year.

Maths

In Maths this half term, we will be covering:

Geometry- identifying quadrilaterals, finding lines of symmetry, and plotting coordinates.

Roman Numerals- writing Roman numerals up to 100.

History and Geography

In Geography, we will be learning about natural disasters through our topic Active Planet. We will learn how volcanoes and earthquakes are formed. Pupils will also focus on what to do in the event of a natural disaster and what governments can do to prevent these disasters. We will study the eruption of Mount Vesuvius in AD 70 and we will write information leaflets about the eruption.

Campaign

Our class campaign this term is linked to 'Keep kind.' Our focus will be on First Aid and we will learn some basic First Aid.

Science

Our Science topic this half term will be around The Digestive System.. We will learn about carnivores, herbivores, and omnivores. We will also learn about human teeth and how they decay. Additionally, we will study a model of The Digestive System and learn how it works in humans.

The Digestive System

ICT

Our topic this half term is 'Programming- repetition in games'. We will use Scratch as a platform to program games.

PSHE

This half term our PSHE unit is Changing me. During this topic, the children will think about and sex and puberty as well as what changes lie ahead in our lives.

RE

Our focus religion this half term is Christianity. Our key question is: Do people need to go to church to show they are Christians?

PE

PE lessons this half term will focus on rounders and cricket.

Music

The children will be exploring Western Classical music.. They will also rehearse their songs for Hackney Music Festival.

Spanish

In Spanish, our focus for this half term is 'weather.' The children will learn how to use language linked to the 4 seasons.

DT

This half term in DT, the children will be looking at structures, we will make a structure of Gainsborough primary school focusing on nets and 3-d shapes and how to join these together to make structures.

Art

This half term Year 4 will learn the skill of paper mache and make volcanoes. They will use colour mixing skills and consider making the art interactive, adding some volcanic smoke!

Cooking

This half term we will focus on Spanish cooking for Hispanic week. Year 4 will make tomato and bread salad, from the Andalucia region of Spain.
