Reading	Writing
This half term we will be reading 'Flat Stanley' by Jeff Brown in our reading lessons. We will be reading 'The Hackney Martian' by Paul Brown as our class reader. We will practise our summarising skills by identifying the main events from what we have read and completing summaries in our reading logs. It is a book full of suspense and mystery that keeps the children on their toes!	Our writing units this half term will be based around our topic of our local area and the book 'The Hackney Martian.' Using this text, the children will write a detailed setting description, focusing on using a wide range of adjectives and adverbs. The children will also write a re-tell of the story 'Eco-Girl', using a range of fronted adverbials. During this unit, the pupils will focus on adding fronted adverbials and adjectives. For example:

Maths	Science
In Maths this half term, we will be covering: Place Value- We will be learning how many tens are in a 2 and 3 digit number, comparing and ordering numbers up to 1000 and counting in 10's and 50's. Addition and Subtraction- using mental and written strategies, such as the column method, to add and subtract numbers up to 1,000 Multiplication and Division- using mental and written strategies to multiply by 3,4 and 8. https://www.bbc.co.uk/bitesize/topics/z36tyrd	Our science topic this half term will be 'Skeletons, movement' and 'diet and nutrition'. We will explore different species' and their skeletons. We will investigate why different animals have different skeletons, and the purpose of each part of a human skeleton. In addition, we will explore diet and nutrition, looking at and comparing diets between species.
