Maths Science

In Maths this half term, we will be covering:

Multiplication and division- using mental and written strategies to multiply and divide within the 2 5 and 10s timetables.

Length- measuring and comparing the lengths of different items using metres and centimetres.

Mass- measuring and comparing the mass of different items using grams and kilograms.

Our Science topic this half term will be 'Materials'. We will explore different materials and their properties.

We will develop our scientific skills by planning our investigations, selecting our equipment, recording our results and observations, drawing conclusions and evaluating the accuracy of our investigation and results.

Our topic this half term is 'Creating media.' We will develop our understanding of using technology to create digital photography. We will use digital devices to create and edit digital images. We will use a range of devices, such as tablets, webcams and cameras to take photographs and different editing programmes and apps to edit these.
This half term our PSHE unit is 'celebrating difference'.' During this topic, the children will think about and discuss how everyone is different from one another. We will also learn about using kind words to help others to feel welcome and what to do when someone is being bullied.
Christianity Our focus religion this half term is Christianity. Our key question is 'Why do Christians believe God gave Jesus to the world?'

This half term in Art, Year 2 will be doing weaving, which ties in with our learning about clothes
