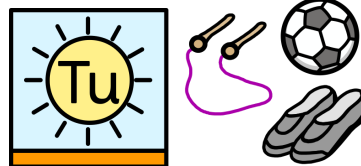

PE Kits

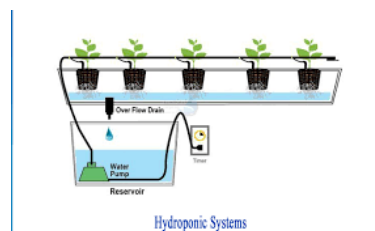
Class PE Day: **Thursday**

Reading	Writing
<p>This half term we will be reading ‘ The Breakfast Club Adventures’ by Marcus Rashford as our class reader. We will practise our summarising skills by identifying the main events from what we have read and completing summaries in our reading logs. It is a book full of mystery, adventure , friendship and teamwork.</p> <p>Our reading lessons will focus on a range of reading skills including:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - Finding information in the text - Understanding new vocabulary in context and considering why an author uses these words - Using clues from the text to work out the feelings of characters - Making predictions about what will happen next <p>To support your child at home, please read with them every day. Children can also access Reading Plus at home using the link below:</p> <p>https://student.readingplus.com/seereader/api/sec/</p>	<p>Our writing units this half term will focus around humorous and newspaper writing. The children will produce a scientific report about the functions and history of parachutes, including writing about our own experiment. They will also write narrative pieces including humour and their own newspaper reports.</p> <p>During these units, the pupils will focus on adding burger sentences to their work. This includes adding extra information (often but not always a relative clause) into a sentence.</p> <p>For example:</p> <p>Parachutes, which are used to slow down the fall of objects through air, operate based on air resistance.</p> <p>Please see the link below for further information linked to relative clauses.:</p> <p>Relative Clauses</p> <p>Please support your child’s spelling at home by encouraging them to learn their weekly spellings.</p>
Maths	Science

ICT	Programming This unit looks at patterns and repeats, breaking things down and creating a program.
PSHE	Dreams and Goals We will discuss the dreams and goals we have for our futures and how we can plan to achieve these. We will understand that we need resilience to achieve our goals and may have to overcome disappointment and challenges along the way.
RE	Islam Our question is 'Does completing a pilgrimage make someone a better muslim' We will look at the core beliefs of Islam and the different ways a Muslim can be committed.

Music	Rock and Roll Music The children will be exploring rock and roll music looking at the Beatles.
Art	This term in Art, the children will be diving into the exciting world of airplanes and travel. They'll practice drawing planes, learn about the bold art style of David Klein, and create their own colorful prints. This journey combines drawing skills, historical art insights, and printmaking to show how air travel connects us globally.
DT and Cooking	Cooking This half term in Cooking, we will be making pastas. In Year 4, we will be learning how to make a tomato based sauce for our pasta.
